Organizational Structure

KP Northern California Externship Program Overview

- Externship program started in 2008 (prior to that, CFY Program)
- We see all ages and all specialties throughout our region
- Typically, one extern position per site
- AuD interns from local programs also rotate through our clinics
- Extern will have a “home” location, but can pre-arrange observation/experiences at other sites



Position Details

- Kaiser Permanente's externship program supports the 12-month placement at full time hours (40 hours per week).
- Externship position is non-exempt without benefits.
- Relocation assistance is not offered for this position.
- We are offering up to \$52,000/year paid at \$25/hour for the duration of your externship*
- Externs must have a Required Professional Experience – Audiology (RPE-A) license from the State of California by date of hire.
- Externs must have non-expired CPR BLS certification from the American Heart Association by the date of hire.
- Externs must be enrolled at a University with an active contract with KP NCAL.

*For 2026-2027 Externship Year

Many of our externs are offered a job opportunity when they graduate.

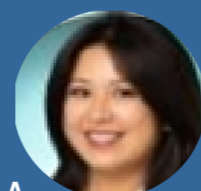

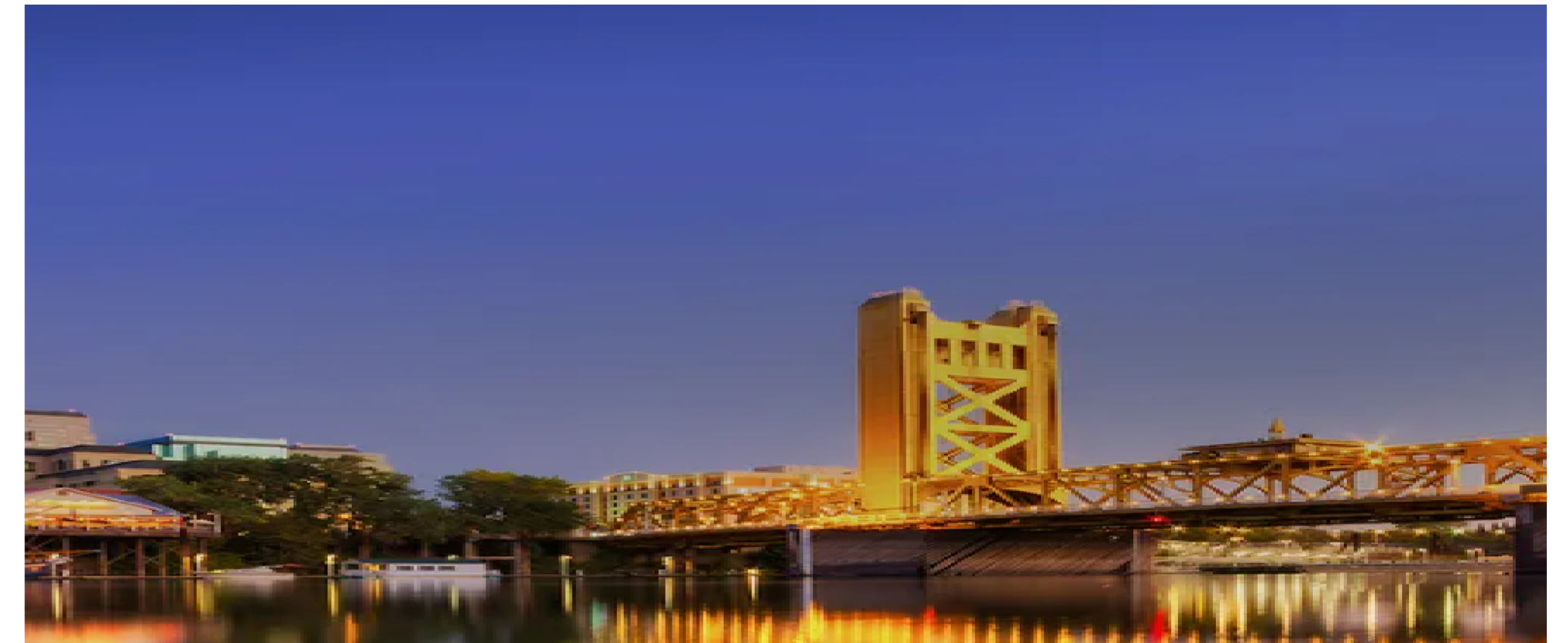
